## Diplomacy, Earnings & AI Fuel the Rally on Wall Street

The S&P 500 and Nasdaq posted consecutive record closing highs, driven by diplomatic progress in the Middle East and a wave of solid corporate earnings that eased economic concerns. Trump indicated that a permanent peace deal could be on the way following weekend negotiations.

Morgan Stanley and Bank of America both reported first-quarter results that surpassed analyst expectations, driven by strong trading revenue. Financial sector earnings remain a key focus as regional banks, including Truist and Regions Financial, report on Friday.

Netflix Inc. slid in after-hours trading after issuing a second-quarter forecast that missed analysts' expectations.

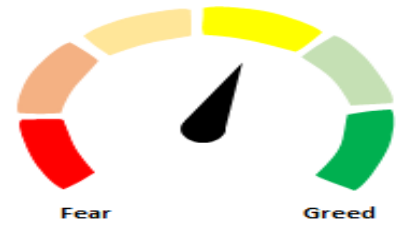
Chip stocks, led by Nvidia, surged as renewed investor confidence in AI's long-term growth potential drove buying interest. Beaten-down tech and software sectors broadly regained their footing this week amid improving risk sentiment tied to progress in Middle East diplomacy.

Crude Oil dropped earlier as a U.S.-brokered 10-day ceasefire between Israel and Lebanon sparked optimism for a broader Middle East resolution, including potential U.S.-Iran peace talks. Growing bets that the ceasefire could be extended, combined with weaker global oil demand forecasts from OPEC and the IEA, further pressured oil prices.

Asian shares opened lower, with Japan's benchmark Nikkei 225 seeing some profit-booking following a record high in the previous session, slipping 0.7%. The Nikkei erased its losses from the Iran war on optimism that the new peace talks may hasten the end to the conflict. The gains come from a years-long rally in Japanese equities, driven by corporate governance reforms, the yen's weakness, and AI tailwinds.

Nifty faced minor profit-taking yesterday, shedding 34 points to close at 24196. The Nifty closed above its 50 DEMA for the second consecutive session, signalling improved sentiment. The 24,000-24,100 band should provide support on the downside, while 24,400-24,570 could act as resistance on the upside.

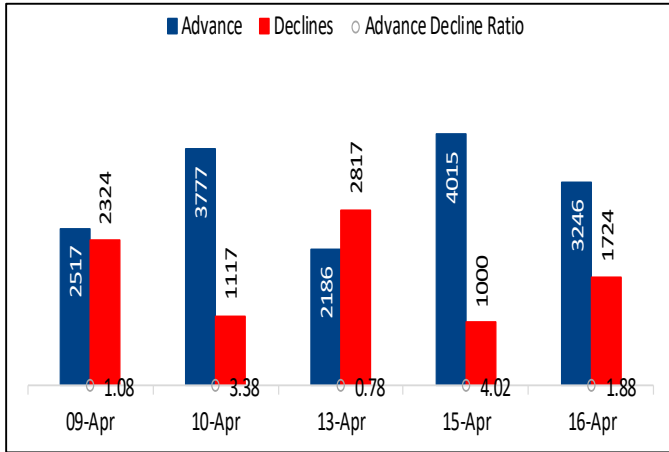

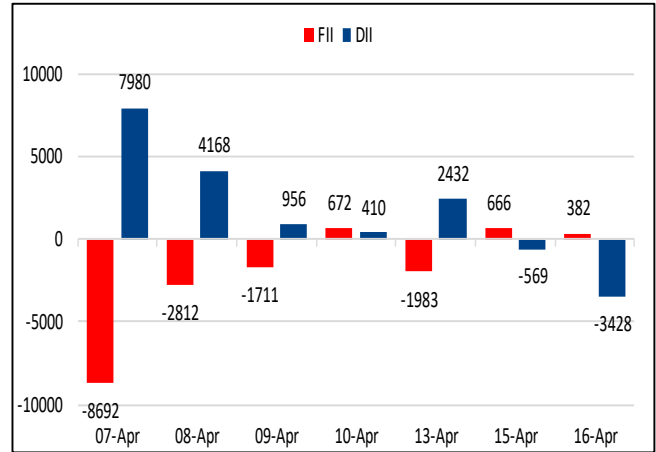

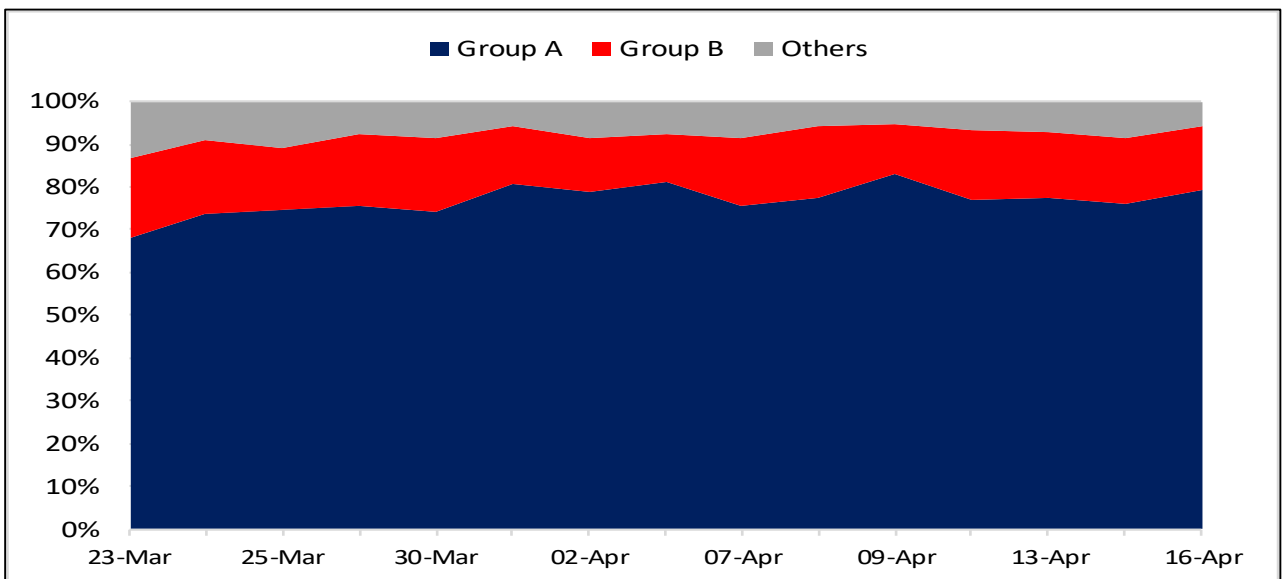

	<b>VST Industries</b>	<p>The company reported a strong performance for Q4, with net profit more than doubling year-on-year to Rs 116.7 crore as compared to Rs 53 crore. Revenue grew 30.9% at Rs 457 crore as compared to Rs 349 crore in the same period last year. Board declared dividend of Rs 12 per share for the year.</p>
	<b>RVNL</b>	<p>The company emerges as L1 bidder for a Rs 967.92 crore construction project of East Coast Railway. It is to be executed over the next 36 months.</p>
	<b>Angel One</b>	<p>Angel One reported strong March quarter results with profit rising 84% YoY, driven by higher trading volumes, improved monetisation, and operating leverage. Client activity rebounded, boosting orders and revenue while wealth management grew, though lending activity saw a sequential decline. Total revenue rose 9.3% QoQ to Rs 1,459 crore. EBITDA grew 13.1% to Rs 599 crore from Rs 529 crore in the third quarter of FY26. Similarly, EBITDA margin expanded to 41% from 39.7% in the comparable quarter. The company has informed that it will raise Rs 1,500 crore via an NCD (non-convertible debentures) issue.</p>

<b>Signature Global</b>	Signature Global has entered into a strategic collaboration with Tonino Lamborghini S.p.A. to develop a premium branded residential project in Gurugram.
<b>KPI Green Energy</b>	KPI Green Energy Limited has been granted an Inter-State Power Trading Licence (Category IV) by the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC). This is in addition to the intra-state power trading licence earlier received from the Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission (GERC), and together, these approvals enable the Company to undertake power trading across India and establish a pan-India power trading platform.
<b>CESC</b>	CESC Limited has signed the Power Purchase Agreements for procurement of Power from Grid Connected Wind Solar Hybrid Power Projects amounting to 600 MW with 4 different entities (One of them being their wholly-owned subsidiary i.e. Purvah Green) at a Tariff rate of Rs. 3.75/kWh.
<b>Automobile</b>	Indian carmakers have agreed to new fuel efficiency rules, CAFE 2027. These norms will limit CO2 emissions for passenger cars starting April 1, 2027. The industry body SIAM finds the guidelines balanced. Automakers will improve fleet emissions annually until 2031-32. The government will issue the final notification soon. There is broad industry consensus on the draft.
<b>Waaree Renewable Technologies</b>	Revenue stood at Rs 1,102.4 crore vs. Rs 476.6 crore. EBITDA was up 63.7% at Rs 206.8 crore. EBITDA margin stood at 18.8% vs. 26.5%. Net profit was up 66% at Rs 155.7 crore vs. Rs 93.8 crore.

<b>Mastek Q4FY26 result preview</b>	Mastek is likely to report 4.9% revenue growth on QoQ basis and 4.9% YoY growth to Rs 950 crore in Rupee terms. In USD terms, revenue could rise by 1.9% QoQ and it could fall by 0.5% YoY to US\$ 104 mn in Q4FY26. Net profit could fall by 5.1% QoQ and it could rise by 15.2% YoY to Rs 103 crore in Q4FY26. EBIT margin could increase by 10bps QoQ and 100bps YoY to 14.2%. The company is likely to comment on the tech spending and order inflow.
<b>Wipro Q4FY26 result review</b>	Wipro's numbers were inline with estimates in Q4FY26, and expects revenue growth from the IT Services business segment to be in the range of -2% to 0% in constant currency terms for Q1FY27E. <b>Board announced buyback of Rs 15,000 crore at a price of Rs 250 per equity share through tender offer route, subject to shareholder approval.</b>  Consolidated revenue was up by 2.9% QoQ and 7.7% YoY, to Rs 24,236 crore in Rupee terms and IT services segment revenue was at \$2,651.0 mn, an increase of 0.6% QoQ and 2.1% YoY. EBIT was up 19.8% QoQ and 7.1% YoY to Rs 4,181 crore. In Q3FY26, EBIT was impacted by higher employee costs, including the impact of past service cost on gratuity due to the implementation of new labour code. EBIT margin stood at 17.3% in Q4FY26 vs. 14.8% in Q3FY26 and 17.3% in Q4FY25. Net Profit grew 12% QoQ, and it was down 1.1% on YoY basis to Rs 3,522 crore.
<b>GAIL (India)</b>	GAIL (India) Limited, signed contract agreements with M/s TUSCO Limited for setting up of 600 MW of solar power project at TUSCO's Solar Park located at Jhansi in Uttar Pradesh. The solar power project will be set up along with a 550 MWh Battery Energy Storage System (BESS). The projects will primarily cater to meet the captive energy requirements of GAIL's Petrochemical Plant at Pata in Auraiya district of Uttar Pradesh.
<b>Zydus Lifesciences</b>	Company has received the Establishment Inspection Report (EIR) and approval letter from the US FDA for the Pre-Approval Inspection (PAI) conducted at SEZ oncology injectable manufacturing site in SEZ1, Ahmedabad, in relation to the new isolator injectable line. ## Key Events

### US Industrial production declines, missing forecasts and previous gains

Industrial production in the United States has shown a notable decline, according to the latest data released. The measure, which tracks the change in the total inflation-adjusted value of output produced by manufacturers, mines, and utilities, recorded an actual decrease of 0.5%. This downturn is significant as it diverges from the anticipated forecast, which had predicted a modest increase of 0.1%.

The unexpected drop in industrial production is a cause for concern among economists and investors, as it suggests a slowdown in the industrial sector's performance. The latest figures contrast sharply with the previous month's data, which had shown a healthier increase of 0.7%. This shift from positive to negative growth may raise questions about the underlying factors contributing to the current economic environment.

### Fed's Miran says may cut rate outlook on inflation concerns

Federal Reserve Governor Stephen Miran said he may reduce his projection for interest rate cuts this year due to inflation that has proven more persistent than expected.

Miran said he is considering three or four quarter-point rate cuts for 2026, down from the four cuts he projected in March. He made the remarks at an event on the sidelines of International Monetary Fund and World Bank meetings.

### US initial jobless claims fall below expectations, signaling economic resilience

In a notable development for the U.S. labor market, the latest data on initial jobless claims has shown a decline, underscoring a potentially resilient economic landscape. The number of individuals filing for unemployment insurance for the first time came in at 207,000, according to the latest report.

This figure not only fell short of the forecasted 213,000 claims but also marked a decrease from the previous week's tally of 218,000. The decline in initial jobless claims suggests that fewer people are being laid off, which could indicate underlying strength in the job market and broader economy.

### UK Feb GDP beats expectations, but analysts warn of slower 2026

The UK economy expanded 0.5% in February, surpassing analysts' forecasts, following an upwardly revised 0.1% growth in January, according to official data released by the Office for National Statistics.

Services activity rose 0.5% month-on-month and industrial production increased 0.5% month-on-month. Construction output jumped 1.0% month-on-month despite unseasonably wet weather in February.

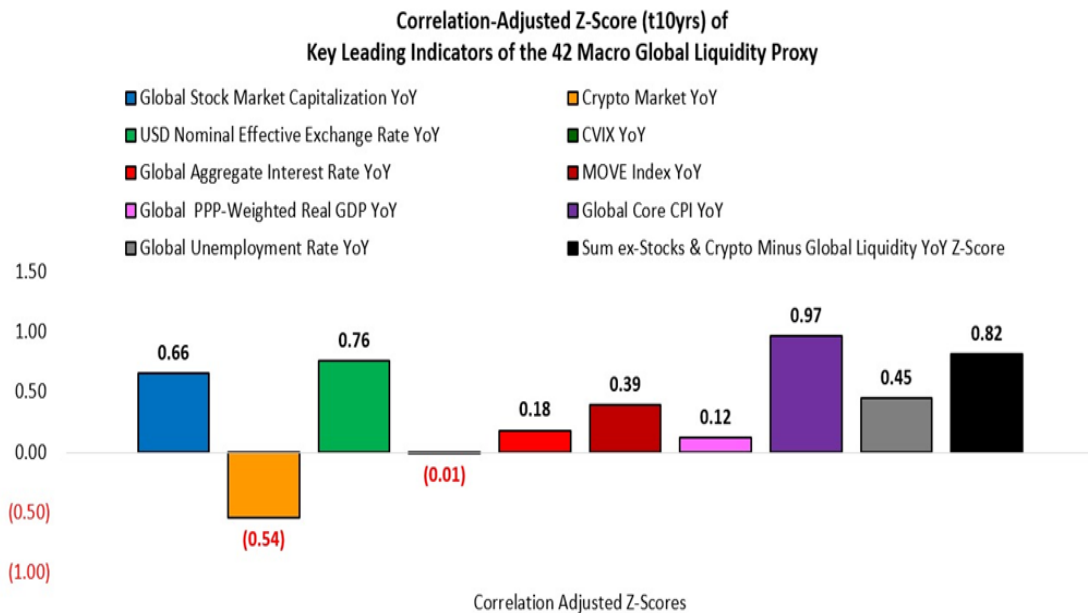
Mining and quarrying output rose 3.9% month-on-month, while wholesale and retail increased 0.7%, transport and storage gained 0.4%, and arts, entertainment and recreation jumped 2.0%. Accommodation and food output fell 0.3% month-on-month, and manufacturing output declined 0.1% month-on-month.

### Global Liquidity Signals Medium Term Uptrend

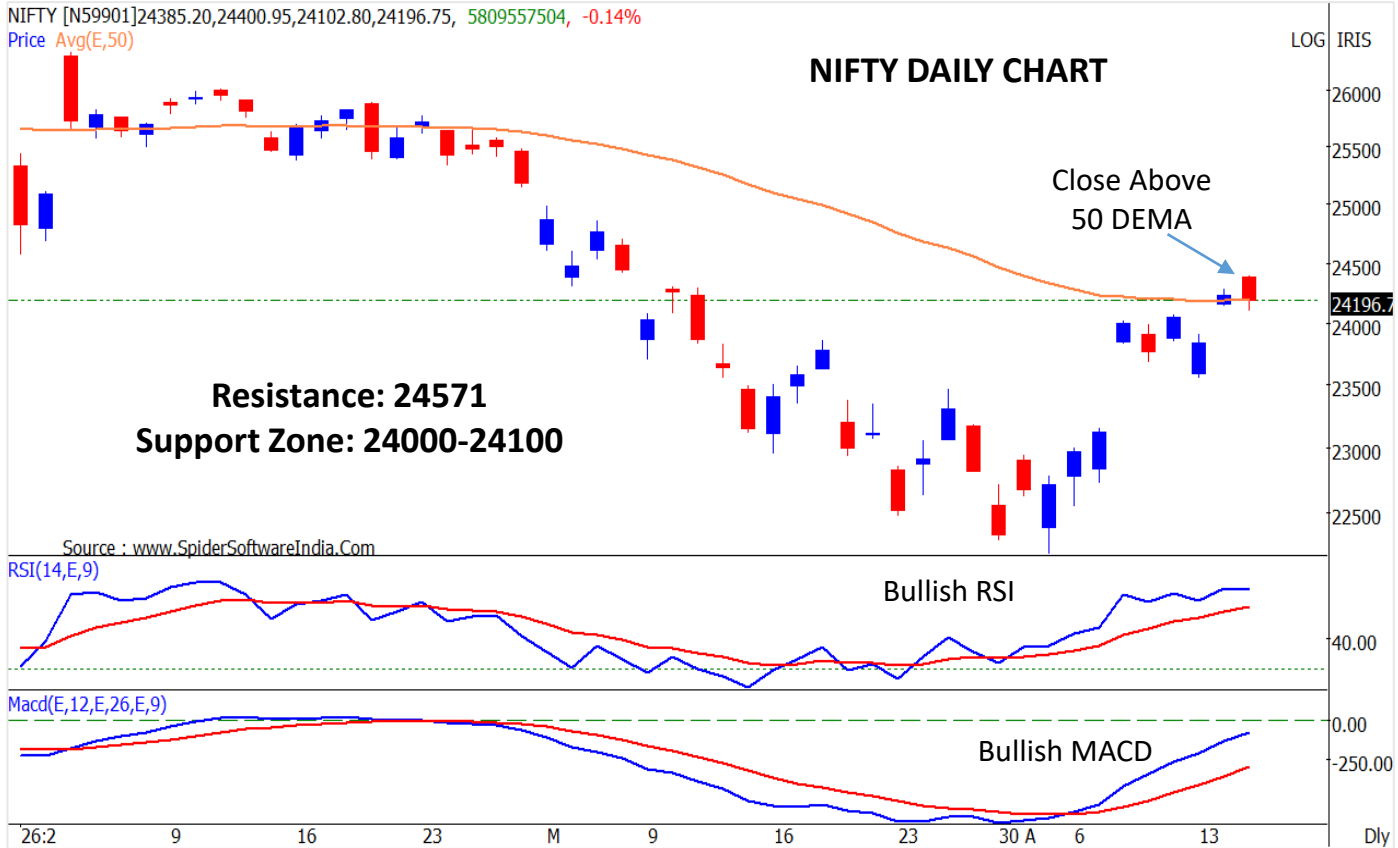
- Positive Liquidity Drivers: Significant upward pressure is coming from Global Core CPI (0.97) and the USD Nominal Effective Exchange Rate (0.76), alongside a strong showing from Global Stock Market Capitalisation (0.66).
- Negative/Neutral Factors: The Crypto Market (-0.54) is currently acting as a primary detractor from the liquidity score, while Global Aggregate Interest Rates (-0.01) remain essentially flat.
- Overall Signal: The black bar (0.82) represents the sum of indicators excluding stocks and crypto; according to the legend, a score between 0.5 and 1.0 signals a "significant uptrend" in global liquidity.
- The Correlation-Adjusted Z-Scores over a 10-year lookback period, aggregating data from central bank balance sheets, broad money supply, and foreign exchange reserves.

## F&O Highlights

### SHORT BUILD-UP WAS SEEN IN THE BANK NIFTY FUTURES

#### Create shorts with the SL of 24350 levels.

- After a strong start, Nifty faced profit-taking and slipped 34 points to close at 24,196. It hit an early high of 24,400, fell nearly 300 points by noon, and later recovered about 140 points to end with a mild loss.
- Long Unwinding was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 1.40% with Nifty falling by 0.14%.
- Short Build-Up was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 0.40% with Bank Nifty falling by 0.38%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio fell to 0.98 levels from 1.12 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (21-Apr Expiry), Call writing is seen at 24300-24400 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 24300-24400 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 24100-24000 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Short covering was seen by FII's' in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 266 cr with their Open Interest going down by 11125 contracts.

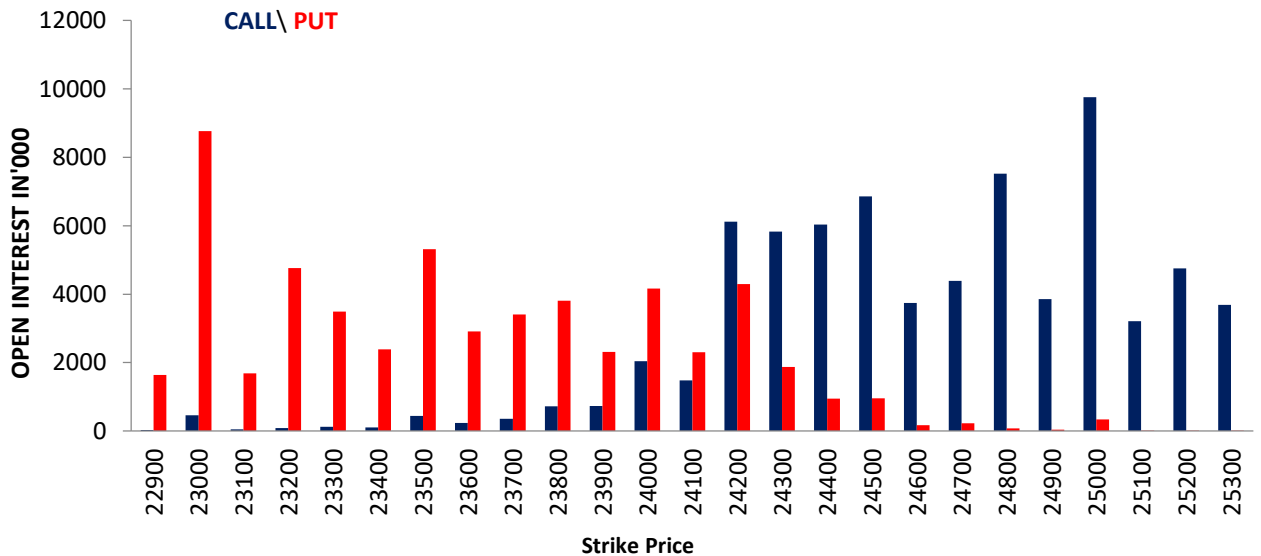
