Dow Advances as Tech Retreats

U.S. stock indexes saw divergent performances yesterday, as a rally in cyclical stocks buoyed the Dow while tech shares pressured other benchmarks. The Dow rose roughly 0.32% to close at 49686, but the S&P 500 and Nasdaq Composite both logged back-to-back losses, sliding 0.07% and 0.51% respectively.

Technology shares faced significant pressure, led by a sharp decline in semiconductor and memory stocks. Industry leaders like Seagate and Micron reported substantial losses after executives' comments suggested that memory chip capacity expansions would take considerable time, raising doubts about the industry's ability to meet surging AI-related demand.

Alphabet stock rallied 2.27%, touching a new 52-week high of \$406. The move came as investors positioned ahead of anticipated catalysts, with Berkshire Hathaway also reportedly increasing its stake in the company.

The 10-year U.S. Treasury yield remained elevated near 4.6% as investors balanced easing bond-market volatility with persistent concerns regarding oil-driven inflation. While yields pulled back slightly from session highs, they remain at their highest levels since early 2025, reflecting a market that is increasingly pricing in a 'higher-for-longer' interest rate environment through the end of 2026.

Crude prices cooled off a little after President Trump announced he had called off a planned strike on Iran, following appeals from Persian Gulf allies. Trump added that 'serious negotiations are now taking place,' spurring optimism that energy flows through the Strait of Hormuz could eventually be restored.

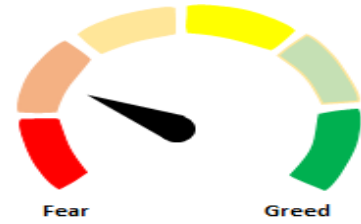
The US Dollar Index slipped toward the 99.10 region as traders digested fresh geopolitical headlines surrounding US-Iran negotiations and an upcoming leadership transition at the Federal Reserve.

The Indian rupee reached a fresh all-time low of approximately 96.36 against the US dollar, making it one of the worst-performing currencies in Asia for the year. This depreciation is primarily attributed to rising US Treasury yields and elevated crude oil prices, which have exacerbated concerns over India's balance of payments and imported inflation.

Petrol and diesel prices were increased by 90 paise per litre on Tuesday, the second increase in less than a week.

Nifty defended its swing low support at 23262 yesterday, keeping the near-term bullish outlook intact. With three out of the last four sessions closing in the green, there are early signs of buying interest emerging at lower levels.

Indian markets are poised to open flat amid mixed global cues. The 23,800 level remains a critical resistance, and a decisive breakout above it will be essential for bulls to regain momentum.



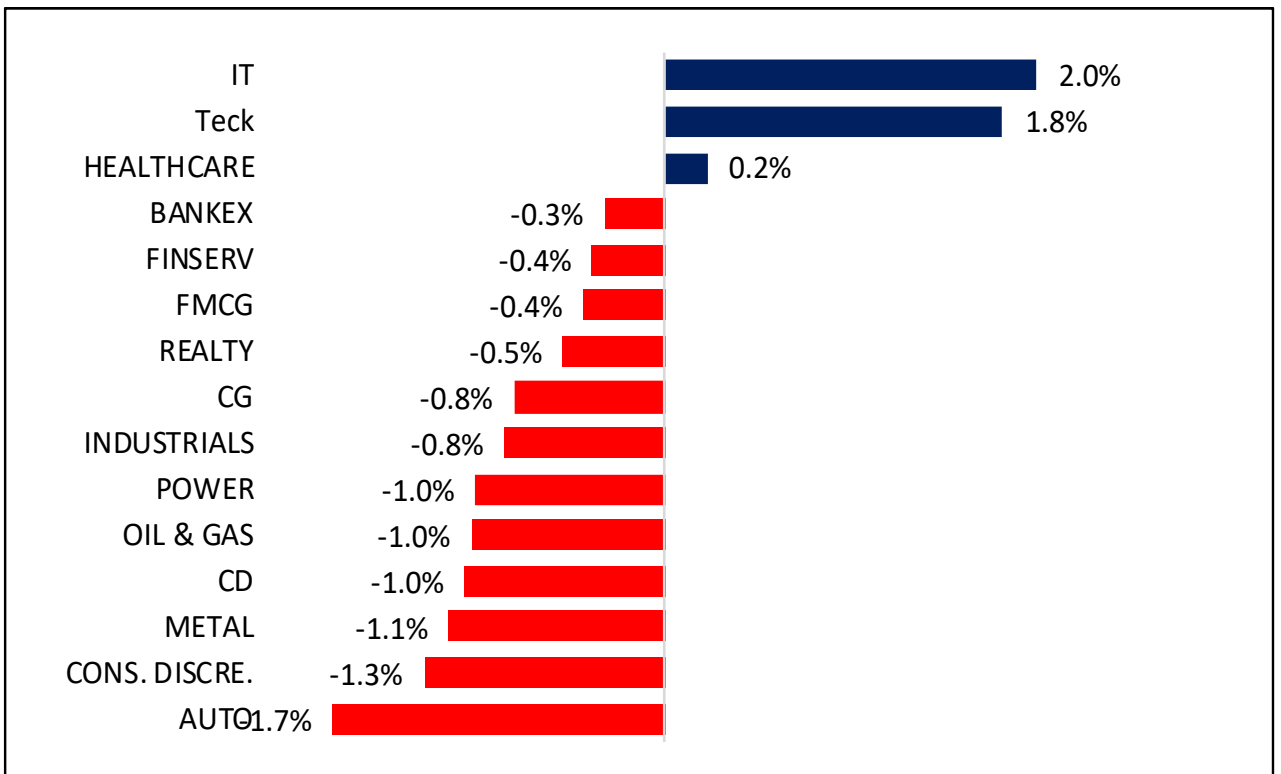

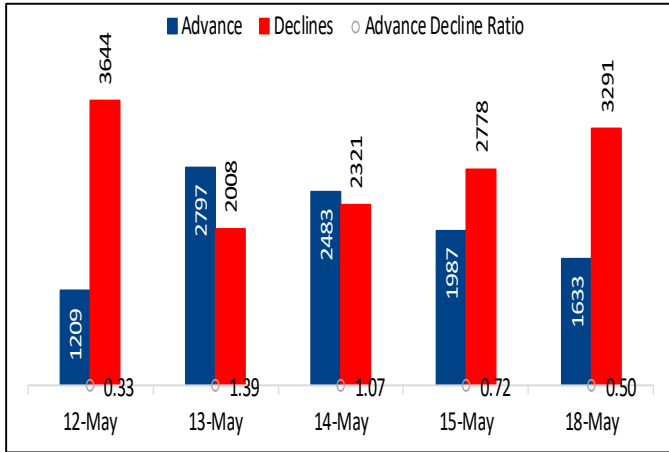

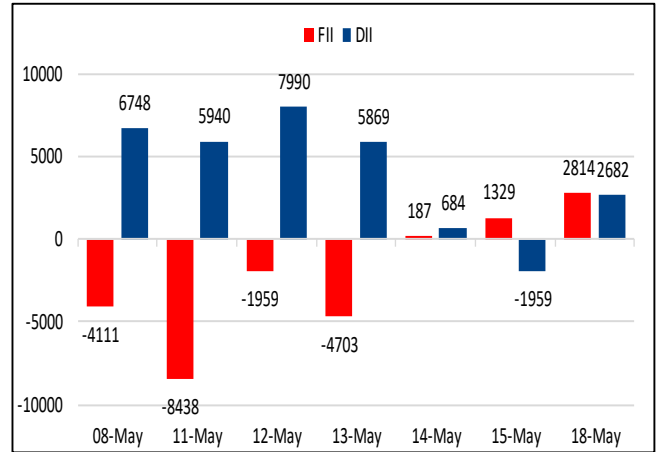

Institutional Activities (Rs Cr)



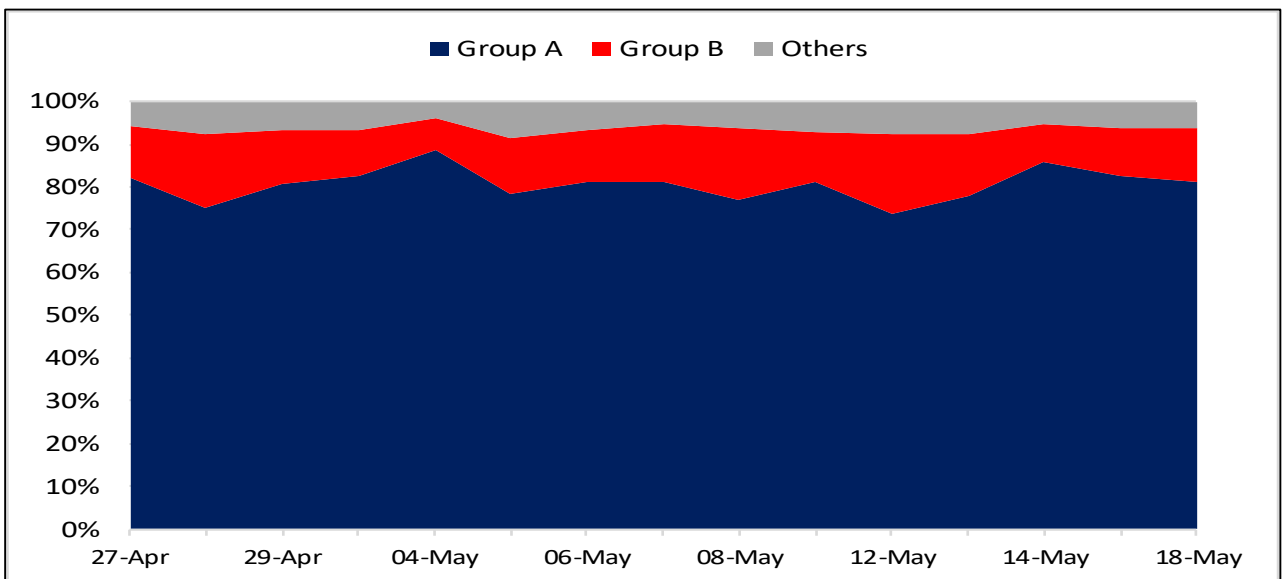

Key Events

China's home price falls narrow, but recovery may be months away

China's new home prices fell at their slowest monthly pace in a year in April, offering tentative signs of stabilisation, though the recovery remained uneven despite local government efforts to boost sales and shore up fragile sentiment.

Analysts said the property market was likely to struggle to find a bottom for several more months, even if prices in major cities begin to stabilise.

"The property market has not yet bottomed out," said Morningstar analyst Jeff Zhang. "Sector indicators are likely to remain weak in the coming months, although sales and prices in higher-tier cities could stabilise."

Zhang said oversupply meant the market could take another one to two years to bottom out and show a broader recovery.

New home prices dipped 0.1% in April from the previous month, narrowing from a 0.2% drop in March and marking the slowest decline since April last year, according to Reuters calculations based on National Bureau of Statistics data.

Japan's economy expands annualised 2.1% in Q1, above forecast

Japan's economy grew an annualised 2.1% in the first quarter, government data showed on Tuesday, compared with the median market forecast for a 1.7% gain.

The growth in gross domestic product (GDP) translated into a quarterly increase of 0.5%, which compared with the median estimate for a 0.4% rise.

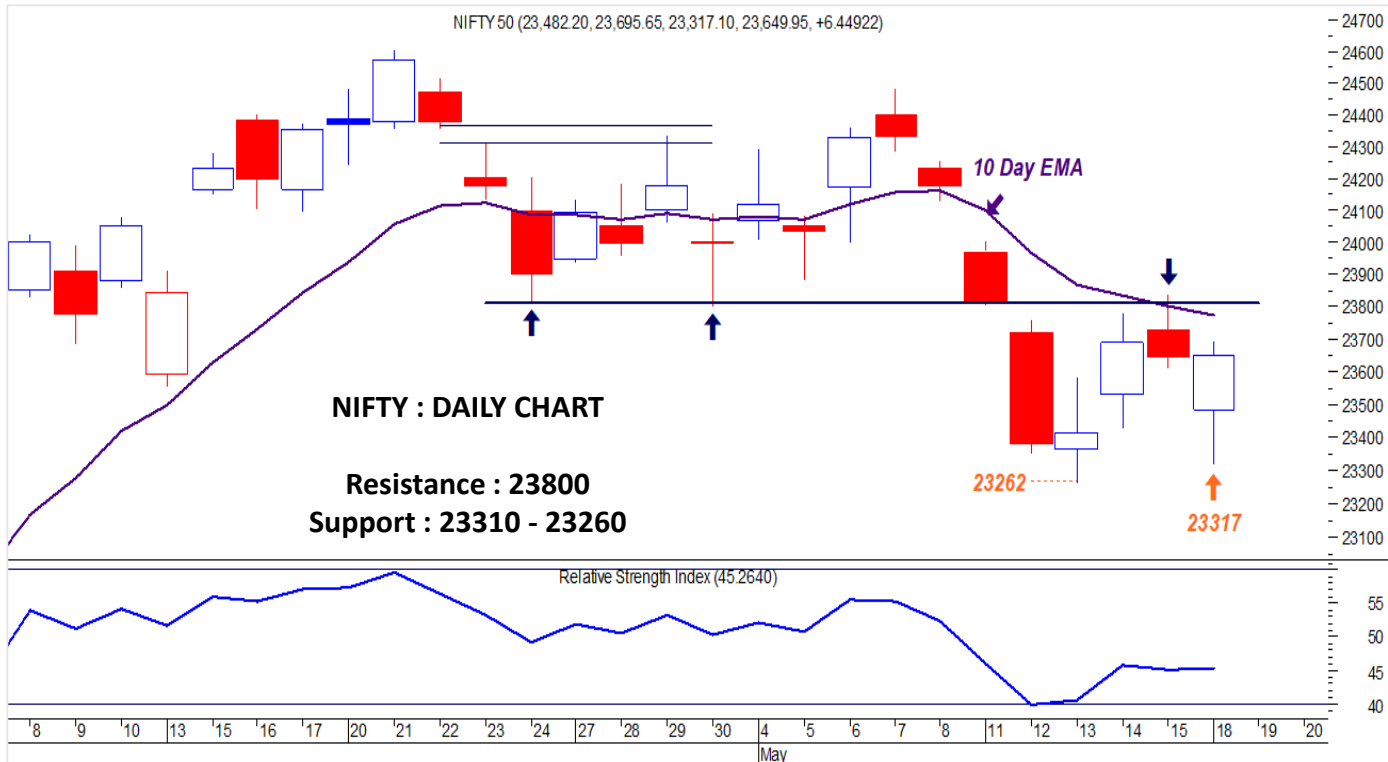
The Physical Economy Is Tightening Fast

- Last time commodities reached this zone, they exploded higher. In 2004, the sector broke through multi-decade resistance and rallied 55% over the next four years. That level had only been tested three times in half a century. Now we're back at that same line — seven years into the current cycle. And in two of those three historical cases, the breakout wasn't the end of the move. It was the beginning.
- This is no longer just a currency debasement story. Roughly two-thirds of the Bloomberg Commodity Index is concentrated in energy and base metals — the critical inputs upstream of AI infrastructure spending and Europe's industrial reshoring push. Meanwhile, supply remains structurally constrained: mine capex remains nearly 30% below 2014 levels in real terms, while the International Energy Agency (IEA) estimates that bringing a new copper discovery into production now takes an average of 16 years.

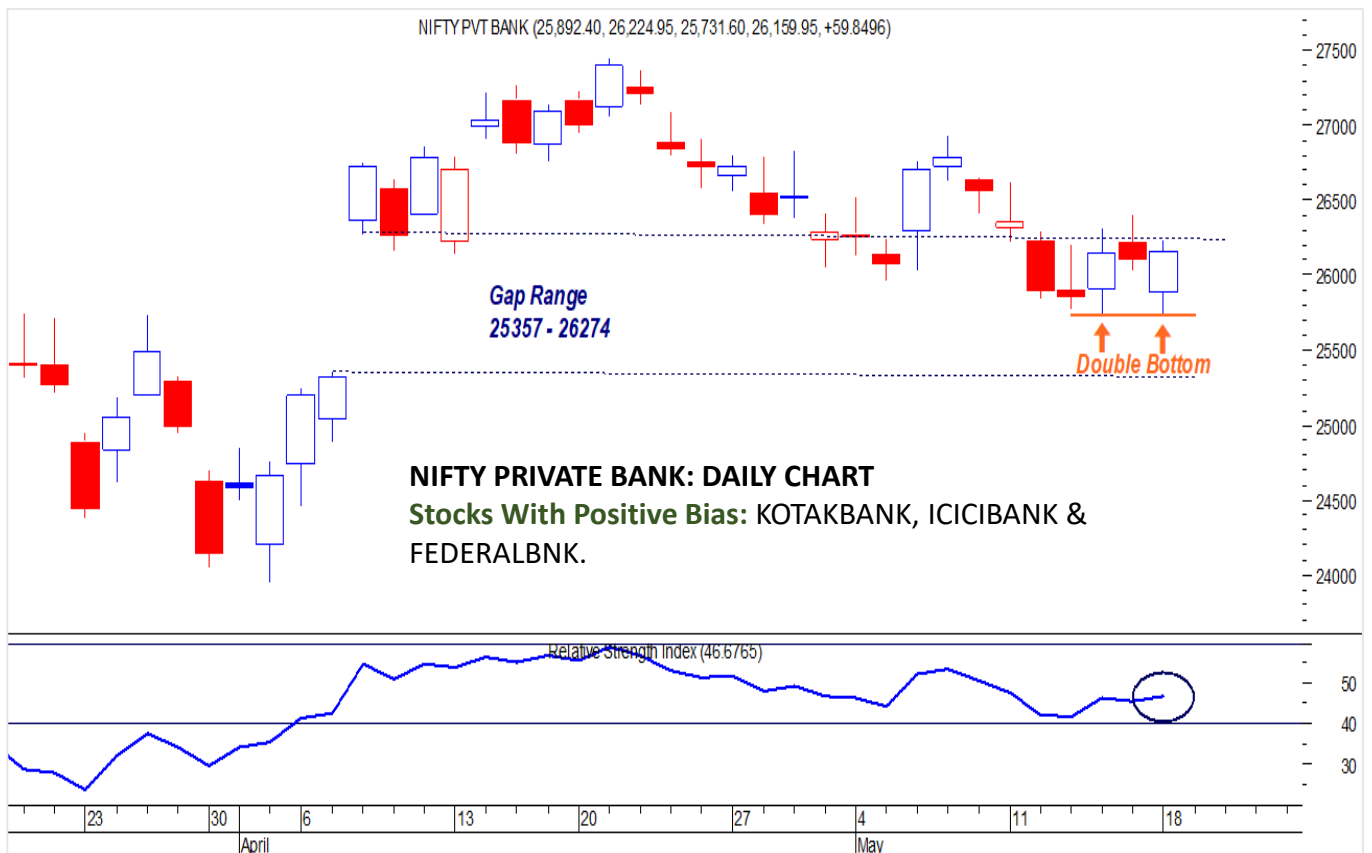

PUT WRITING WAS SEEN AT 23400 – 23500 LEVELS

Create longs with the SL of 23500 levels.

- Nifty started the day with a gap-down opening on back of weak global cues and extended its early decline in the first 45 minutes. However, sentiment turned decisively positive post 10 a.m., as strong buying interest emerged, leading to a recovery of 378 points from the intraday low. Nifty finally settled almost flat, up 6 points at 23,649.
- Short Covering was seen in the Nifty Futures where Open Interest fell by 3.24% with Nifty rising by 0.03%.
- Short Build-Up was seen in the Bank Nifty Futures where Open Interest rose by 0.53% with Bank Nifty falling by 0.32%.
- Nifty Open Interest Put Call ratio rose to 1.24 levels from 1.01 levels.
- Amongst the Nifty options (19-May Expiry), Call writing is seen at 23700-23800 levels, indicating Nifty is likely to find strong resistance in the vicinity of 23700-23800 levels. On the lower side, an immediate support is placed in the vicinity of 23400-23500 levels where we have seen Put writing.
- Short covering was seen by FII's' in the Index Futures segment where they net bought worth 1,002 cr with their Open Interest going down by 8449 contracts.

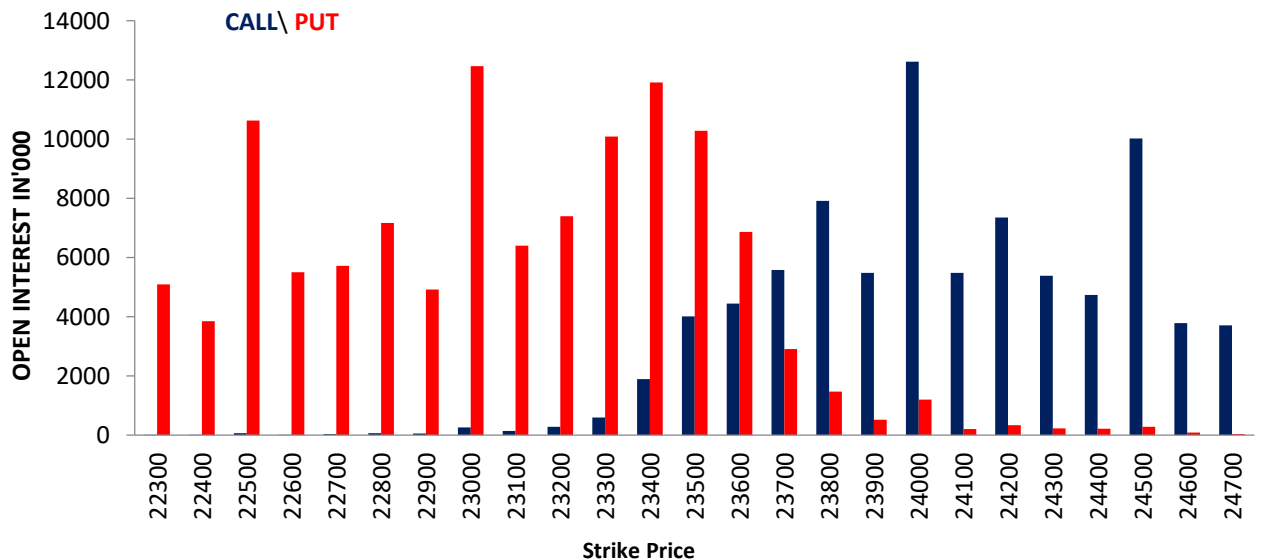
